- Grow your skills and your community—one hopeful conversation at a time

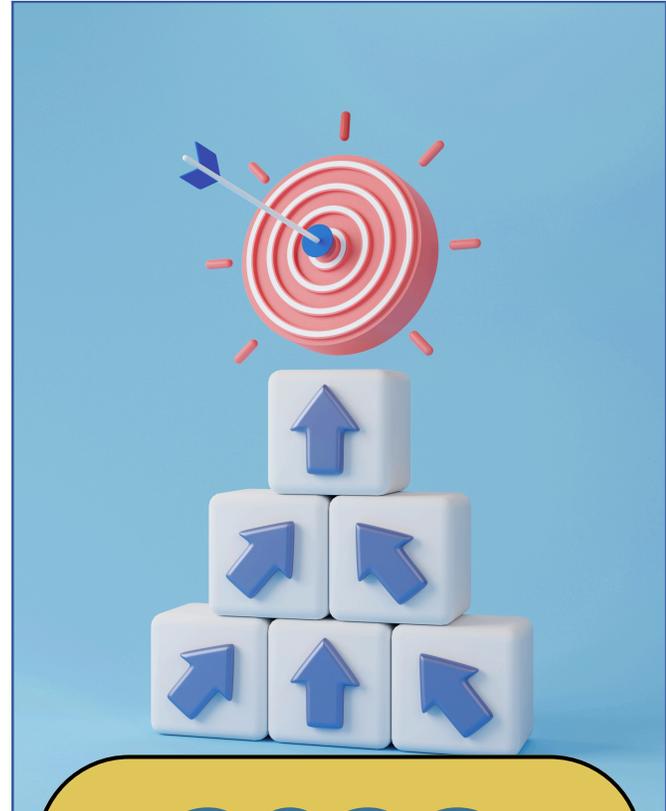
