Dreaming, Pathways, and Agency in Family Treatment Courts

Learn how Family Treatment Courts are translating hope into action through the Pathways to Progress project

This session will explore how hope-centered work begins with dreaming about well-being, clarifying shared goals rooted in dignity, equity, and stability, and how those dreams can be translated into practical, hope-centered projects.

Using the **Pathways to Progress** project as a case example, we'll examine how therapeutic courts and partners created new ways to provide concrete supports to families that increased hope for both families and the professionals working alongside them.

We'll focus on lessons learned from implementation, including:

- what worked,
- what challenged teams, and
- how shifting from scarcity to possibility supported more equitable outcomes.

The session will include an educational conversation and a facilitated fishbowl focused on practical insights participants can apply within their own roles, agencies, and court communities.
