



A COMMUNITY APPROACH TO SUD TREATMENT

A cross-sector, community-based response to prevention, treatment, and recovery

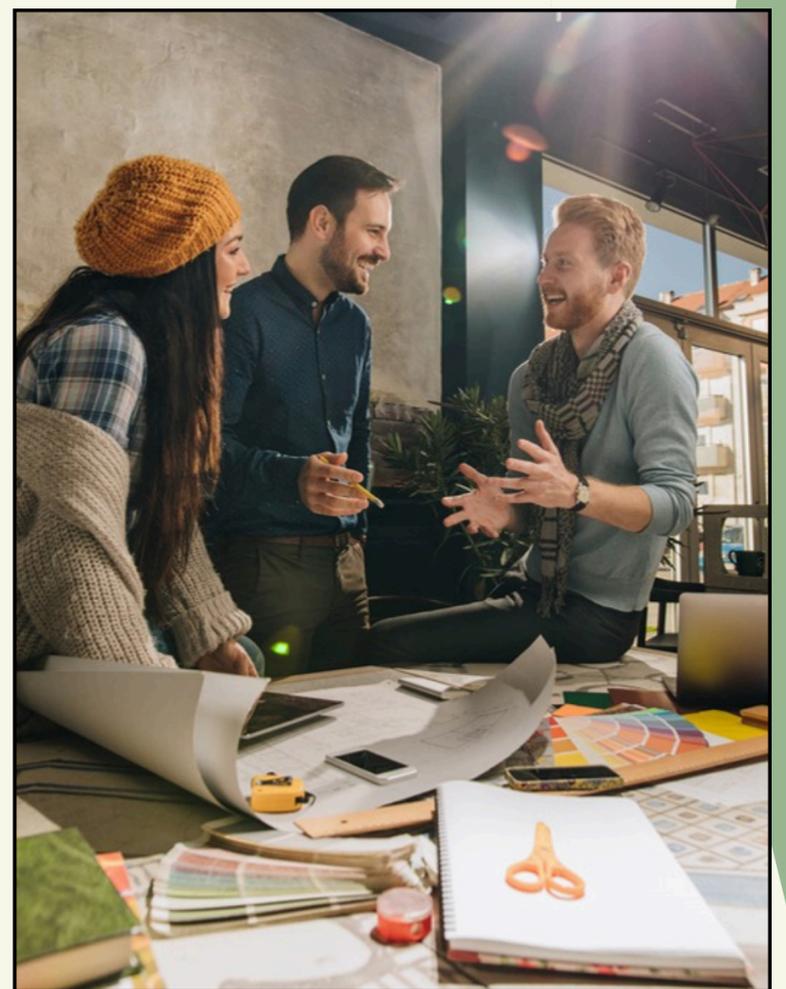
Substance use disorder (SUD) impacts individuals and families across prevention, treatment, recovery, and long-term stability. A coordinated community-based response is essential.

This Hope Community of Practice will highlight Kittitas County's community approach to SUD treatment and recovery through the [Kittitas County Health Network](#).

Community organizers, health providers, treatment partners, and system stakeholders align around shared goals and coordinated pathways. A monthly community partner meeting that strengthens collaboration and strengthens problem-solving.

In this session, participants will hear:

- How Kittitas partners across sectors to address SUD from prevention through recovery
- What a coordinated, community-based response looks like in practice
- How shared goals and regular partner meetings strengthen connection and problem-solving
- How collective hope grows when communities align around shared goals, clear pathways, and coordinated action



The session will include facilitated reflection, inviting participants to consider where a community approach is strong in their own region, and one small step they can take to strengthen it.
